Vicky Alvear Shecter has also written several books for elementary and middle school children including, Cleopatra Rules! The Amazing Life of the Original Teen Queen and Alexander the Great Rocks the World. In 2011, she decided to take the plunge into the Young Adult Literature world, with the release of Cleopatra's Moon. In May of 2014, she released her latest Young Adult novel, Curses and Smoke: A Novel of Pompeii. Vicky was born in 1961, in Hollywood, Florida. As a kid, she always dreamed of becoming an archeologist. When she entered college, she abandoned those dreams, and decided to major in English. She began to find her passion of the past, when she told her kids some of the stories that she had heard about Cleopatra, Rome, Greece, and many ancient civilizations. She decided to write books about her knowledge, and the storyline for Alexander the Great Rocks the World fell into place. In 2011, Vicky decided to switch to Young Adult Literature, and released Cleopatra's Moon.
